Translation is not a barrier, the exercises kept us active, we now know how to map our strengths and resources

"Alliance India is a non-governmental organisation working across 17 states of India. Alliance India's programmes foster wellbeing, realise equality, and affirm the dignity of communities most affected by HIV/AIDS.

The key communities that Alliance India are working with includes (but not limited to): people who inject themselves with drugs including women who inject drugs; men who have sex with men; transgender and 'Hijra' people; women in sex work; and people living with HIV.

Interventions include prevention, care and support for HIV and AIDS, community advocacy including empowerment to access sexual health services, addressing gender-based violence, and developing the capacity of the community to address violence against transgender and hijra groups. Alliance India have reached 1.52 million people with their services since 1999.

Caplor Horizons was introduced to us by Sharon Turnbull in 2018 and we have worked with them on three occasions since then.

Our first session in May 2018 focused on strategy development. It was facilitated by Ian (Williams). We enjoyed working with Ian and he was an excellent trainer/facilitator to work with. More than anything else I think the technical (academic) inputs he provided appealed to our team immensely and the experiential learning hit home the issues that we are already dealing with. His analysis was spot on. These views were shared by the rest of the team:

More recently in April 2019, Ian and Rosie contributed to our 'LINKAGES' initiative. This involved building the capacity of Community Based Organisations (CBOs) in Maharashtra and Andhra Pradesh. The members (pictured below) focus on HIV prevention, care and treatment services among key populations at risk of HIV.



The facilitators encouraged the use of song, dance and roleplay as a way to embed the learning around topics such as proposal writing and resource mobilisation. Another interesting tool that was used was The Voyage Board which helped the CBOs articulate their envisaged future and how they plan to get there.

It was a team effort with members of the Alliance India team working alongside Caplor Horizons to make it so successful, including the inspirational and steadfast leadership roles that Abhina and Sylvie contributed. Some feedback from participants included:
